What does the Black and Gold Gala benefit?

The Black and Gold Gala will benefit of the mission of St. John Paul II High School, a private nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization. St. John Paul II High School is proud to serve South Texas as an income-based, college-preparatory Catholic high school. St. John Paul II High School provides 75% of students with 50% or more in tuition assistance. Your support of the gala aids our mission to prepare all students, regardless of financial need, for "this life and the next".

How does the Casino Night work?

For our Casino Night event, you will either receive chips as part of your sponsorship package or donate money at the event to receive chips to play (\$10 for \$500 chip). Games will include poker, blackjack, craps, and roulette. At the end of the evening, you redeem your chips for raffle tickets (worth \$500 chips). There will be several prizes with raffle baskets. Raffles will be drawn at the end of the evening. The Casino opens at 8pm and ends at 11 p.m., with the raffle winners being announced.

What if I am not the gambling type?

This is an event with something for everyone. There will be great food, spirits, music, and dancing. In addition to gaming, there will be a silent auction and live auction with many items from which to choose and bid on. If you do not know how to play any of the games, our dealers will be more than happy to help explain the rules. Fun for all is guaranteed.

What is the schedule of events for that evening?

Doors open at 6 p.m. After check-in, you will be able to grab a drink and browse, silent auction items, and mingle with the other guests. After a quick introduction, dinner will begin at 6:35 p.m. Presentations will begin at 7:20 which will lead into the Live Auction. The Casino will open at 8pm. Silent Auctions will close at 8:30. The casino night will end at 11 p.m., with the raffle winners being announced.

Are there ID requirements or an age limit to enter the event?

ID is only required to purchase at the bar.

What are my parking options getting to the event?

There is plenty of parking near the American Bank Center on Shoreline or paid-parking in the ABC garage.

What should I bring to the event?

You should plan to bring extra cash in case you want additional casino chips to play with or are planning to bid on the silent auction. We will also be able to process credit card transactions for the auction items and on sight registration.

What is the dress/attire for the evening?

The suggested attire is cocktail attire. If you dress as if you are going to go to a real casino, you will neither be overdressed nor underdressed.
